

Summer Transition Tasks

The following tasks are to be completed over the summer break and handed in during your first lesson. Please clearly label work with your name and place it in a plastic wallet if you have one.

Task 1 Reading

Read article 1and article 2 of 'El Boletín', using the key words sheet to help you with the vocabulary. Alternatively, use <u>www.wordreference.com</u> to look up any unfamiliar language. For each article, find the phrases under the magnifying glass in each paragraph of text. For article 1, read the sentences 1-5 and decide if each phrase is true (verdadero) or false (falso) based on what you have just read. If the statement is false, try and correct the sentence so that it is correct. For article 2, answer the questions (1-3) in Spanish, using the language you have read in the text. This does not need to be answered in full sentences.

- What was the role of the woman during the dictatorship? How has this changed?
- What challenges do young people face nowadays in Spain / Latin America?

Make some notes in English and/or Spanish about what you find out.
